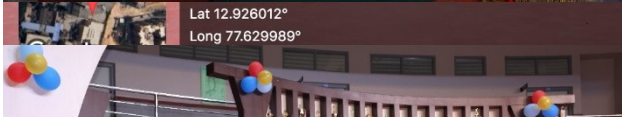
Outcomes:
