

TRAFFIC AWARENESS PROGRAMME

DATE: 16th NOV 2024

A Traffic Awareness Program was conducted at Anil Kumble Signal, Bangalore, from 7:30 AM to 10:30 AM. The initiative, led by Yukti volunteers in collaboration with the Red Cross Unit Bangalore, aimed to educate the public on road safety and promote adherence to traffic regulations. With 30 participants, the program was coordinated by Ananya Ravi, with student coordinators Pv Gnanesh Kumar and Pragya Goyal leading the efforts.

The primary goal of the campaign was to raise awareness about road safety and responsible driving behavior in one of Bangalore's high-traffic areas. Volunteers focused on reducing accidents by educating commuters on the importance of following traffic rules, pedestrian safety, and the use of helmets and seatbelts.
