**Report or Overall Summary:**

On September 27, 2024, a comprehensive awareness program on traffic rules was organized by the Adugodi traffic police station at the Traffic Police Park, Bengaluru. The initiative aimed to educate participants about the importance of adhering to traffic regulations for the safety of all road users.

The primary objectives of the program included:

- Raising awareness about traffic rules and regulations.
- Highlighting the significance of safe driving practices.
- Reducing traffic accidents through education.

The Head Constable Ravi Kumar, an experienced traffic educator, took a session and emphasized the significance of road safety, highlighting the importance of helmets, signboards, different types of marks on roads, and responsible speed limits. He additionally

demonstrated proper helmet-wearing techniques and also explained the meaning behind various traffic signs.
